In September we will be using a "mood board" to create in our journal. Don't worry if you don't know what a mood board is. Just join us for a fun, artsy day.

#### Coastal Watercolor Workshop

Come learn the style of The Messy Painter and her signature coastal watercolors! In this workshop you'll learn wet on wet, wet on dry and dropping in techniques to create colorful and vibrant sand dollars, starfish and a seahorse! This class is for all levels, and supplies are provided. You'll also receive a brief overview of watercolor basics to get started. Supplies provided, but students are welcome to purchase or bring their own from the class supply list. Supplies: Princeton Pointed Round brush sizes 1 or 2 and 8 or 10, Watercolor tubes in: prussian blue, cobalt blue, sap green, hookers green, lemon yellow, cadmium orange, opera rose and alizarin crimson OR, Watercolor pan set with primary and secondary colors, Canson or Arches Cold pressed watercolor pad 9 x 12. Included: Watercolor Basics booklet, water cups, linens/paper towels.

#### Product Playground "Distress Crayons & Gelatos"

#### "Finding Joy in Abstraction"

Join me for an exploration in abstract painting. Abstract painting might seem random, but it is based in composition and color theory. The skills you learn will be useful whether you later use them for backgrounds or as stand-alone abstract pieces. We will work on boards to create interesting foundations and looks with our acrylic paints and other mixed media supplies. After we've practiced, we'll create a canvas. The end result will be gorgeous multi-layered paintings. Bring your journal, too, for practicing and taking notes. We will have lots of messy, artistic fun! Please bring: Basic tool kit: Ranger craft sheet, scissors, water container to clean your brushes, baby wipes, paper towels, paper plate or palette paper to use as a palette (or you can just use your craft sheet). You may also want a small notebook and a pen for taking notes, A tub of white gesso, Your art journal.

#### "Joy of Gelli Printing"

Come and get an introduction to gelatin-style mono-printing with the Gelli Arts printing plate. We'll go over printing basics as well as several different techniques for achieving unique and many-layered prints. Gelatin printing is fun and addictive! We will make our prints into a quick & easy little journal. **Please bring:** Basic tool kit: Ranger craft sheet, scissors, water container to clean your brushes, baby wipes, paper towels, paper plate or palette paper to use as a palette (or you can just use your craft sheet). You may also want a small notebook and a pen for taking notes, Your art journal (I recommend the Dylusions journal by Ranger), 12" paper cutter, Gelli plate (if you have one. If not, I will have a very limited number to share in class), Rubber brayer.

#### "Facing the Facts"

I always say I don't know how to draw, yet I have taught myself how to draw faces. Guess what, you can draw faces, too! I will teach you how to draw a face with easy tips and tricks. I'll also show you how to paint the faces with artistic, fun colors. Even if you can't draw, you can learn to draw faces.
